Highlight of the Seminar:

The speaker, Ir Raymond Wong, has studied China's development since the 1990s. His focus of studies includes building and civil projects of mega size, as well as issues related to general urban development. His foot print again, is more focused in mega cities in particular Shanghai, Guangzhou, Chongqing, Beijing, as well as many fast-growing line one or two cities.

China projects have several unique features that Hong Kong's practitioners may not have chance to see or handle before. For example, many China projects are of very large size in term of land and building area. They use quite a number of structural steel works both for super high-rise or other special structures. Other than that, many projects are being run in "cluster", sometimes with 10 or even more associated projects working in the same land area and at the same time. And of course, China has her own procurement method, site planning, work practices and technology used to suit their own industrial background. Surprisingly, most of these jobs are running reasonably good, safe and efficient.

In this seminar Raymond will try to summarize what he observed in China for the past 20 years and shows audiences what is all about.

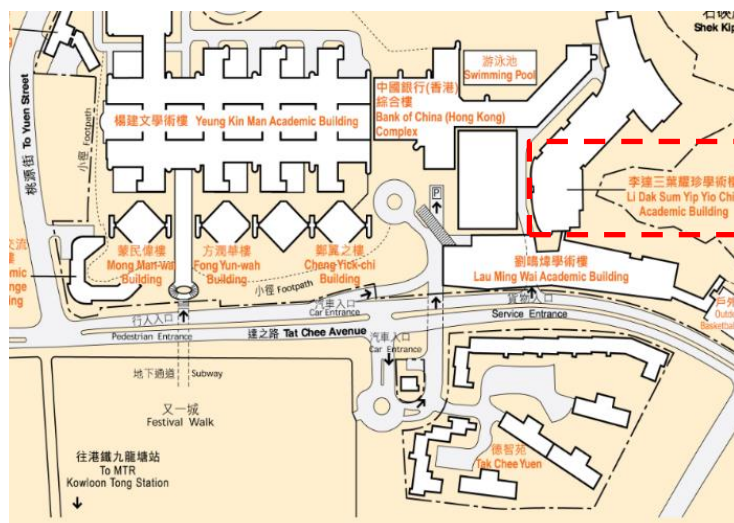
